



2024 COMTO Future of Transportation Scholarship Program SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATION – FALL 2024

Overview

The Northern California Chapter of the Conference of Minority Transportation Officials (COMTO NorCal) is a national, multi-ethnic professional organization founded in 1971 to advance the representation of minority professionals in the transportation industry, nurture their career growth through networking and training, and champion equitable transportation development. A cornerstone of COMTO's work is supporting the next generation of transportation professionals and providing financial support for students in need. This is COMTO NorCal's 21st Scholarship Awards Gala.

COMTO's annual Future of Transportation Scholarship Program is currently seeking applicants through **Deadline Extended October 25, 2024** for scholarship awards of \$2,000 – \$6,000 each.

Eligibility

- Undergraduate and Graduate minorities who are Northern California residents or are actively enrolled in an accredited community college or university in Northern California
- Demonstrated intent to pursue a career in transportation, including (but not limited to):
 - o Transportation Planning
 - o Transportation Engineering
 - o Mobility as a Service
 - o Public Policy
 - o Environmental Science
 - o Aviation Science
 - o Department of Transportation (DOT)
 - o Federal Aviation Administration (FAA)
 - o Equal Opportunity in Contracting and Employment
 - o Business, Communications, Government Affairs, and related
- Demonstrated major or coursework in disciplines applicable to transportation including (but not limited to):
 - o Urban Design/Urban Planning
 - o Engineering: Civil, Construction, Mechanical, Electrical, Environmental
 - o Business: Communication, Economics, Public Health, Policy, IT
 - o Social Sciences: Political Science, Pre-law
 - o Aviation: Management, Aeronautics, Air Traffic Control (ATC), Professional Pilot

Requirements

- Applicants must have a minimum grade point average (GPA) of 2.5 or above.
 - Community College students must be in a specific degree program or demonstrate intent to transfer to university.
 - Undergraduate students must be beginning their sophomore, junior, or senior year.
 - Applicants must demonstrate a commitment to advancing disadvantaged communities of color.
- **Winners are encouraged to attend a COMTO event or meeting to receive the scholarship** December 6, 2024, 6:00 - 8:30 p.m. Awards Program or meeting (virtual acceptable); Scholarship funds will be mailed to the winners after the December 6 event
 - **Students may receive scholarships a maximum of two times** from this COMTO chapter.

Application Process

Applicants must package and submit **all** the following:

- **Completed Student Application form.** (Item A below)
- **Letter of Motivation:** (Item B below, **250 – 500 words**)
- **Statement of Financial Need:** (Item C below, **250 – 500 words**)
- **College Transcripts** – (Item D below, most recent college transcript showing cumulative GPA)
- **Resume** (Item E below)
- **Two References** (Item F below) – From: (1) college instructor, counselor, or advisor and (2) professional, academic, or personal reference.

Note: Additional consideration will be given if your reference prepares a letter on letterhead paper from the organization with which they are affiliated.

B. Letter of Motivation Essay – Think about what drives you to attend and complete college as well as pursue a career in transportation. In 250-500 words (double-spaced) address the following:

- Describe your life goals
- Describe your transportation-related career aspirations

C. Statement of Financial Need – Think about your financial situation. In 250-500 words (double-spaced) address the following:

- Explain how you are paying for college now.
- Explain difficulties you are having in meeting your needs.
- Talk about how you would benefit from the scholarship.

D. College Transcripts – Please send your most recent college transcripts. Include your entire college history with all grades. Transcript does not have to be an official transcript.

E. Resume – Provide a resume (up to 2 pages) that includes information on your work experience, volunteer activities, education, honors/awards received, and other interests.

F. References – At least one reference from a college instructor, counselor, or advisor. Additional letters from professional, academic, or personal references will be accepted. Letter of reference should answer the following questions:

- What is the reference's relationship to the applicant?
- When did the reference meet the applicant?
- What is the time period (month/year) that the reference has had knowledge of the applicant's work or character?
- How would the reference describe the quality of applicant's work?
- How would the reference describe the applicant's character?
- Why does the reference recommend the applicant for the scholarship?
- **CONFIDENTIALITY: Reference may provide the letter to the applicant (whether sealed or not) so that it may be submitted along with other application materials. *If confidentiality is desired, return letter to applicant in sealed envelope or, send directly to COMTO of Northern California as follows:***
